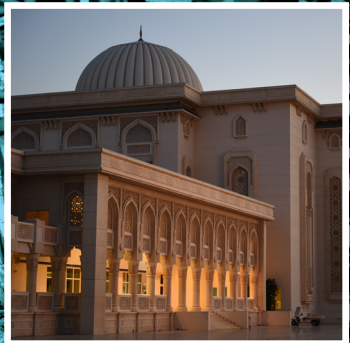
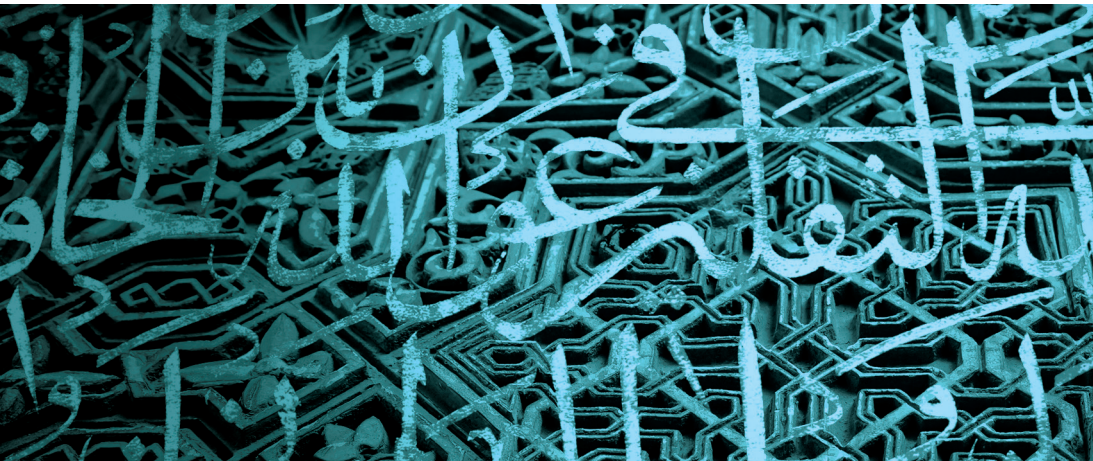


# Study Arabic in the United Arab Emirates!
