About AUS



Visa Information

Upon acceptance to AUS, students will receive a pre-arrival guide detailing the process of applying for a visa. Once at AUS, IXO will advise you on how to proceed as requirements are subject to change.

Students will apply for a 1-yr residence visa and a UAE national ID. A blood test and chest x-ray are required for visa issuance which must be done *in-country*.

Accommodation Options

40% of AUS students live in dorms on campus.

Private:

Single occupancy with a private bath and kitchenette

Health Insurance Information

All students are required to submit proof of international health and travel insurance prior to arrival.

Medical Examination: Undergraduate students are required to have a physical during orientation week. This includes a complete blood count, blood grouping. Students may be exempt from this requirement only if they can provide documentation of a blood grouping/urinalysis from the past 6 months. Otherwise they will be required to complete this at the University Health Clinic for a fee (100 AED). In addition, they will still be required to have a blood test and chest x-ray as part of visa processing.

Proof of International Insurance: All students are required to have international insurance coverage, effective from the day of arrival in the UAE through the date of departure. Students will be placed under Plan II insurance at AUS. The cost is AED 300 and allows access to all health clinic facilities and services. Students may also purchase health insurance from the university, in which case they will be placed under Plan I insurance costing AED 600.
